### Privacy Officer Vacancy

The Privacy Act 2020 came into force on 1 December 2020, replacing the Privacy Act 1993. While the Manager must have a good understanding of the principles involved, the NZSG has traditionally had an Appointed Officer responsible for this role and is now looking for a suitable person to fill that role in the immediate future.

Duties include:

- Familiarity with the privacy principles in the Privacy Act
- Ensure that the organisation is in compliance of the Privacy Act



- Deal with any complaints
- Deal with requests for access to personal information, or correction of personal information
- Liaise with the Office of the Privacy Commissioner.
